Located within a few hours' drive of nearly one-third of the nation's population and 20 percent of the country's business addresses; 60 miles from Philadelphia, 125 miles from New York and 175 miles from Washington, DC

- Number of hotel rooms: More than 17,500
- Second largest gaming market in the United States
- Number of casino resorts: Nine
- Number of Sportsbooks: Nine
- The first permanent Boardwalk was built in 1870 to keep sand off of hotel carpets
- Beaches & Boardwalk: More than five miles of world-famous Boardwalk and FREE white sandy beaches
- Citywide meeting, convention, and event space: 1.8 million square feet
- Number of golf courses: 20 championship-caliber courses within a short 30-minute drive

Transportation

- Atlantic City International Airport is located 12 miles outside of Atlantic City and is serviced by Spirit Airlines.
- Philadelphia International Airport is located 60 miles from Atlantic City and is serviced by over 30 airlines.
- Rail Terminal is provided by NJ TRANSIT and connected to the Atlantic City Convention Center.
- Motorcoach Transportation is provided by NJ TRANSIT and Greyhound bus services.
- Jitney Transportation is powered by compressed natural gas. This people mover runs throughout the city or can be tailored for a specific route for your event. \$2.25/person/way
- Boardwalk Tram Service: One way ticket costs \$4.00/person, \$2.00 for kids (under 12)
- Rideshare: Cabs, Uber, Lyft
